- ⇒ Some partial scholarships are available through our “Friends of OASC” program. See enclosed form to apply. Limited funds are available!
- ⇒ A \$75 non-refundable deposit must accompany each application (sorry, we cannot reserve space without a deposit.)
- ⇒ The balance must be paid in full by July 2, 2010. We cannot admit delegates to camp if their balance is not paid in full.
- ⇒ A Participant Commitment form must be signed by parent/guardian and returned with the registration form.
