

Presenting a Workshop at OASC

Your workshop should be **fun** and **interactive** but you **MUST TEACH** something that students can take back to their school / group / life too!

Essentials to a successful workshop -

- **Warm-up / Opening Activity**
 - Should be related to your topic. Don't do a game just to do a game.
 - No need for a name game (with the #'s it would take the whole time), just introduce yourself and/or other speakers
- **Teaching**
 - You should use a variety of methods for all learners (auditory, visual, hands-on)
 - Make sure your technology works and have a backup in case it doesn't
 - Time yourself. The workshop should be **40 minutes**. If you finish early – have a plan!
DO NOT RELEASE YOUR WORKSHOP EARLY . . . It disrupts other groups!

We do have access to two DVD carts and a few screens. We will do what I can to make it work for you – however if I don't know until the last minute, it gets harder. Please be flexible and plan in advance.

If you have a MAC make sure you bring your own "dongle" or connector to a projector.
