Cited below are the parts of our constitution that directly refers to the selection, terms of office and meeting attendance of OASC Executive Board Members. Also below are bulleted key points and job duties. We are a working board. It is assumed that in addition to your “board duties” that you would be actively recruiting, seeking donations and being a positive role model and representative for OASC.

- Three year term (unless finishing the term for another board member)
- 4 Board Meetings a year (August, Nov, Jan and April) Includes Fall and Spring Conferences
- Email communication with Sara Nilles which may include award judging, SEC selection, advice, recruitment etc . . .
- ONE newsletter article and ONE “tips” article a year to Heather Ransom hansom@grantspass.k12.or.us she will also gladly accept as many lessons as you wish to contribute☺! You’ll want to send her a headshot photo for the newsletter as well.

Taken from the OASC Constitution:

ARTICLE VI – EXECUTIVE BOARD

Section 2. Membership: The Executive Board shall consist of 21 members.

- A. Eight of the Ten Board Members shall be made up of secondary school principals, assistant principals, directors/advisors of student activities, student council advisors or leadership teachers. It shall consist of educators from both middle level and high schools, representing a cross-section of school size and geographical areas. These 10 Board Members are appointed by the OASC Executive Director with input from the OASC Executive Board.*

Section 3. Membership – terms of office.

- A. All members listed in part A of Section 2 shall serve three year terms.*
- C. An Executive Board member who has one unexcused absence from a Board meeting may be put on probation. Two unexcused absences may be cause for dismissal. The position of an Executive Board member with an excessive amount of excused absences may be declared vacant by the OASC Executive Board and the position filled as provided in Section 2 of this article.*

Section 4. Chairperson: The OASC chairperson shall be elected by the OASC Executive Board.

Section 5. Meetings: The Executive Board shall meet at least four times each year; in August, January, and at the Fall Conference in November and Spring Conference in April. The chairperson or majority of the Board may call a special meeting. A quorum shall be five members.
