Evaluation	<p>Student reflects in writing about 5 or more pieces of what went well, what didn’t work well, and gives suggestions on how to make the event even more successful.</p>	<p>Student reflects/evaluates in writing 5 or more aspects of what went well, what didn’t work well.</p>	<p>Student reflects/evaluates in writing less than 5 aspects of what went well, what didn’t work well.
