Some of their roles include planning and promoting state-wide conferences and workshops, developing curriculum for ever changing school climates & culture, preparing and presenting workshops, leading a state-wide service project, being a positive role model and representing the student leaders of OASC.

## **Who can apply?**

Current 8th graders, Sophomores and Juniors

## **What are the offices?**

President, 2 At-Large Representatives, 7 Regional Representatives (Northwest, Metro East, Metro West, Midwest, South, Central, East) and 2 Mid-Level Representatives.

## **What's the term?**

Members of the SEC should be dedicated to their office. Their term takes office immediately after being elected at Fall Conference and they serve until Fall Conference of the Following year. Those elected to the SEC should plan on attending all 4 board meetings (including the proceeding SEC retreats), OASC Fall and Spring Conferences and at least one session of OASC Summer Camp. Other duties included contributing to the OASC Newsletter, helping at workshops in your region and communication with members of the OASC Board.
