Code of Conduct for Student Executive Council

To hold an office in the Student Executive Council is a privilege and an honor. Students should always be mindful that they represent their school as well as OASC.

OASC will reinforce and uphold the rules and expectations for student conduct at the student's school. This applies to all school sponsored activities, home or away. If a student loses his/her office at school due to an infraction of school rules, he/she is in jeopardy of losing his/her OASC position.

When participating in an OASC and/or an NASC (National Association of Student Councils) activity, the OASC Student Executive Council members are expected to adhere to the rules of that activity. They are also expected to adhere to the following (but not limited to) rules:

Any of the following types of misconduct during OASC/NASC participation may result in removal from office:

- Showing disrespect to adults or fellow students
- Vulgar or profane language
- Fighting
- Lewd or otherwise inappropriate behavior
- Not maintaining a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or mood-altering substances OR attendance at functions where such substances are present.
- Any other activity that could bring discredit to OASC,
 - Including inappropriate or disrespectful use of Social Media (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)

As specified in the OASC Constitution, there are four (4) OASC Board meetings per year. Attendance at these meetings is mandatory. If a student is unable to attend, he/she must notify the Executive Director and State President prior to the meeting to have the absence excused. One or more unexcused absences may be grounds for dismissal.

Infractions to the above rules, and rules listed for OASC/NASC sponsored activities will be reviewed by the Executive Director and OASC Board and may be grounds for dismissal.

By your signature, the student participant, adviser, and parent agree that he/she shall comply and abide by the terms and conditions of this Code of Conduct throughout the term of your office.
